### ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN LIBERAL ARTS AND SCIENCES (ASLAS) Emphasis: Social Work (UALR)

The Associate of Science in Liberal Arts and Sciences (ASLAS) is designed for students who wish to take the first two years of a four-year program with specific requirements before transferring to a four-year college or university. This ASLAS with an emphasis in Social Work represents a written transfer agreement with the University of Arkansas at Little Rock (UALR). Students who complete this ASLAS are eligible to apply to UALR's Bachelor of Social Work (BSW) program. Students pursuing this ASLAS must maintain a 2.5 overall GPA as well as a 2.5 GPA for social work prerequisite courses. Students who plan to pursue an ASLAS should begin working with an EACC advisor as soon as possible to review degree requirements and to design a degree plan that will maximize transfer hours.

However, this course will transfer in as a lower level elective and will not replace the UA Little Rock Developmental Psychology course for other majors. It will transfer in as a lower level elective only.

\*\*\*The UA Little Rock BSW program will accept PSY 2063 to satisfy the program requirement for Abnormal Psychology. However, this course will transfer in as a lower level elective and will not replace the UA Little Rock Abnormal Psychology course for other majors. It will transfer in as a lower level elective only.

## Appendix A: Admissions Requirements

### UALR Admissions Requirements for Transfer Students

Transfer students with less than 12 transferrable hours must supply the following with their application for admission:

- High School transcript
- ACT, SAT or ACCUPLACER scores taken within the last five years
- Proof of two MMR immunizations
- Official transcripts from each of the colleges attended

Students with more than 12 transferrable college credit hours with a GPA of 2.5 on all previous regionally accredited college coursework will need to submit the following for admissions:

- Official transcripts from each of the colleges attended
- Proof of two MMR immunizations

### BSW Program Admission Requirements

Students can apply to the BSW program after completion of:

- At least 53 credits (including completion of the core curriculum) completed or in progress
- At least one of three course prerequisites (or the EACC College equivalent) with a grade of C or better: SOWK 1301 (SOC 2023) Introduction to Social Work; SOC 2300 (SOC 2013) Introduction to Sociology; and PSYC 2300 (PSYC 2003) Psychology and the Human Experience.

Students should submit an application and 3 letters of reference to the UALR BSW program in the spring semester prior to the fall in which they plan to start the BSW program (see <https://ualr.edu/socialwork/bachelor-social-work/> for application materials).

### Prior to beginning the BSW program, students must:

- Successfully complete the AS in Liberal Arts and Sciences program
- Successfully complete all three prerequisite courses (or the EACC College equivalent) with a grade of C or better: SOWK 1301 (SOC 2023) Introduction to Social Work; SOC 2300 (SOC 2013) Introduction to Sociology; and PSYC 2300 (PSYC 2003) Psychology and the Human Experience
- Have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA as well as a 2.5 GPA in the social work prerequisites to be admitted to the program.

Students must maintain a 2.5 overall GPA as well as a 2.5 GPA for social work courses.
