

On Monday, June 10th, the Thirteenth annual East Arkansas Community College Golf Tournament will be held at the Forrest City Country Club's 18-hole course. We are eager to hit the greens this year and we hope you plan to participate as both a sponsor and a player in this enjoyable event.

We are in the process of accepting tournament sponsors for the 2024 tournament. The Major Sponsorship is available in the support level amount of \$10,000, Co-Sponsorships are available for \$5,000, and Hole Sponsorships for \$1,000. The deadline to become a tournament Major or Co-Sponsor is Friday, April 26th. After this date, all Major and Co-Sponsors will receive representation on signage, printed materials, and regional media releases. Sponsorship agreement forms are included with this letter. All proceeds from the tournament will benefit the EACC Foundation and donations to the Foundation are tax-deductible.

The number of flights will be determined by the number of entries. Cash prizes will be awarded to the top three teams in each flight, and this year's tournament will also feature a number of exciting prizes and contests.
