

Registered Nursing Instructor

East Arkansas Community College is currently accepting applications for the position of Registered Nursing Instructor. The Registered Nursing Instructor is responsible for preparing and implementing teaching and evaluation strategies for nursing students in the classroom and clinical settings. This instructor position is on a 10.5-month annual schedule.

TYPICAL FUNCTIONS

The individual must: be able to teach didactic and clinical components, perform teaching activities including classroom instruction, classroom management, and grade submission, prepare and implement teaching and evaluation strategies for nursing students in the classroom and clinical settings, and participate in development, planning, implementation, and evaluation of nursing curriculum. The individual must maintain professional standards of practice in teaching in the classroom and clinical settings. Perform other duties and services for the College and Department as assigned by the Director of Nursing and EACC Administration.

Physical Demands and Work Environment:

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to sit, talk, hear, and use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects. The employee must occasionally walk, reach with hands and arms, and kneel or crouch. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision and distance vision. The employee will be required to work in a high traffic area, with frequent public contact. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate. The employee must be willing to work in an office that utilizes overhead LED lighting.

Minimum Qualifications:

Successful applicants must have a Bachelor of Science in Nursing, a minimum of two years clinical nursing experience, and an unencumbered Registered Nursing License.

Base Annual Salary: \$50,111/year (\$31.12/hour) - \$57,333/year (\$35.61/hour) based on education and experience.
